Comments on the Proposed Sewage Project at Sauble Beach

I do not support the proposal that the Town of South Bruce Peninsula invest in a sewage system at this time. There is a great deal of uncertainty about the source of pollution in the river. Therefore the installation of a sewage system for cottagers may not effectively mitigate pollution of the beach via the river. The town needs to conduct a complete study to ascertain the source of the pollution and its effective remedy.

The Cuesta Planning Consultants' June 10, 2010 Discussion Paper "Sauble Beach Settlement Areas Growth Strategy" implies that the investment of sewage infrastructure is a necessary condition for the development of Sauble Beach Settlement Area into a year-round community. However, the Cuesta study contains no market study that might support the likely success of developing Sauble Beach into a year-round community. In my view, for historical and other reasons, Sauble Beach is unlikely to be a viable year-round community for a long time. Even worse is the Cuesta study suggestion that senior citizens homes be established in the beach as an instrument of development. The harsh winter months at Sauble and distance from nearest hospitals make it a very poor location for senior citizens residences.

In summary the proposed sewage system is not an effective means either for controlling beach pollution or for developing Sauble into a year-round community.
