#### **SUBJECT: DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT (ESR) FOR WATER AND SEWAGE WORKS AT SAUBLE BEACH**

**RECOMMENDATION:** THAT Council approve the draft Environmental Study Report (ESR) for Water and Sewage Works at Sauble Beach.

**BACKGROUND:** As Council is aware, the environmental assessment (EA) for this project was re-opened in April 2010 for the following key reasons:


- Concern expressed by the Ministry of Environment over the peak flow;
- The bids received in January 2010 for the project were 20 percent over budget; and
- The uncertainty of system sustainability for the future of a small system.

The current Addendum 3 reviewed all materials and concepts that had taken place for approximately the past ten years and sought community input as to what system sizing would be required. The attached report speaks to this matter in detail.

The phasing of the system as being proposed, along with additional funding being secured will offer viability in taking on this project if Council decides to.


